Looking back upon 2017, it was a year of program transition for Gateway Greening.

With Gateway Greening’s Urban Farm, 2017 was our 11th year at the site. When the farm opened, we had hoped to be there three years. The land is owned by the Missouri Department of Transportation, and we knew one day that development would come to the site. It was announced early in 2017 that 22nd Street will be extended through the farm site due to a reconfiguration of the I-64/Jefferson Ave interchange. Therefore, instead of investing additional resources into this site for a year or two, the decision was made through a strategic planning process with the board and staff to close the farm at the end of the growing season.

With the farm closure, Gateway Greening shifted in 2017 to build upon our core programming and our strengths. One new project introduced in 2017 was our Giving Grove orchard program. Partnering with the Giving Grove organization in Kansas City, we brought this program to St. Louis to both add orchards to community and school gardens and also to create

stand-alone orchards. These fruit and nut trees and shrubs will provide new opportunities for produce to communities across St. Louis.

In our education program, interest in school gardens continued to increase. Our partnership with St. Louis Public Schools developed as our educators not only provided direct teaching, but also grew our efforts with professional development and support for the teachers utilizing school gardens.

As a year of transition, 2017 provided the foundation for the future of Gateway Greening. That future will see Gateway Greening having a greater impact on St. Louis and its communities. We are energized about the future.
