

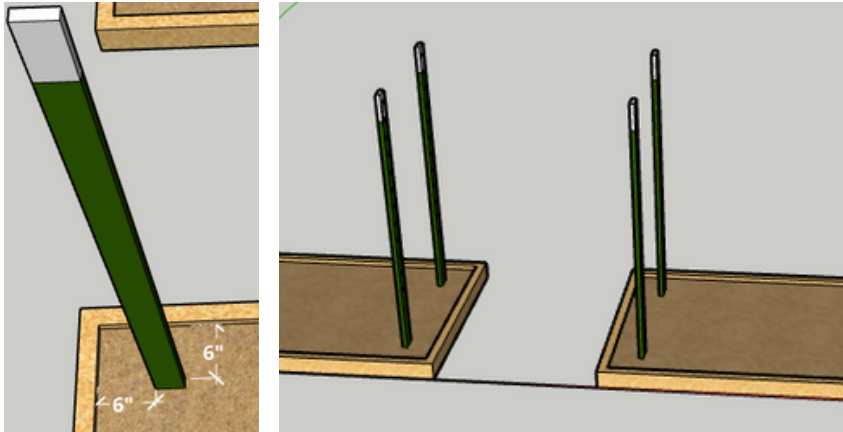
Benefits of Cattle Panel

Using cattle panel is a great way to get a quick trellis for beans, squash, or other vine crops without having to build a complicated structure. This design allows easy installation for raised beds.

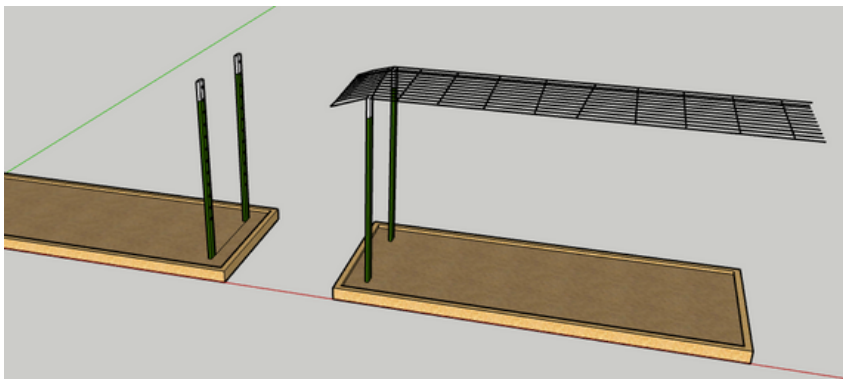
Materials and Tools

- 16' Cattle Panel
- Four 10' T-Posts
- Zip ties
- Post installer

Installation



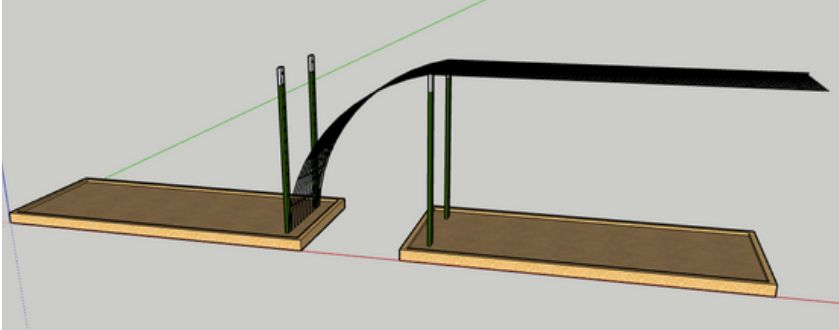
Begin by installing the four T-posts, one in each corner of the raised beds. Install each post 6" from the side.



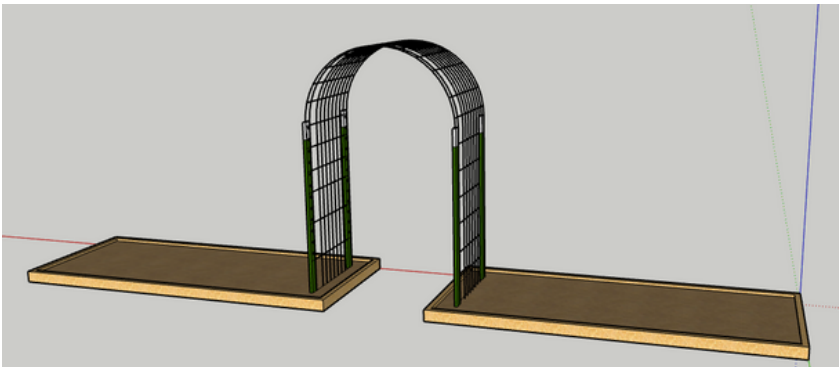
Orient the cattle panel horizontally so that it is parallel to the ground. Begin carrying the panel over to the T-posts. Position the panel so that it begins to overhang the first set of T-posts.

How-To Guide

Cattle Panel Trellis Arbor



Begin to bring the panel down towards the T-posts on the other side, until the edge of the panel is touching the base of the T-post.



Bring the back side of the panel forward until it is in front of the T-posts. Bring the edge down until it is touching the base of the T-posts. Secure the panel to the T-posts with zip ties.
