

Benefits of Using an IBC Rain barrel

Reduces soil erosion

Reduces water runoff

Supplies healthier and purer water for plants

Saves on excessive municipal water usage

How To Use an IBC Rain Barrel

- Position the IBC tote on cinderblocks (or other strong material) on a level surface near a gutter downspout
- The height of the tote will determine the water pressure when in use
- Cover the top hole of the barrel with half-inch hardware cloth and mesh screen to filter out dirt and keep mosquitoes from entering
- Divert the downspout of the gutter directly into the top opening of the IBC tote
- Drill a hole on side of the barrel near the top for the overflow pipe.
- Attach the pipe, making sure to position the water overflow away from the foundation of a house or structure
